Introduction

The Charles Bebeye Ndiomu Foundation having looked at the present state of education in the country and the need to give equal opportunity to those that by virtue of parental loss cannot carter for their academic pursuit, initiated a much needed intervention plan that will help tackle the issue of making quality education accessible and affordable to the less privileged in our society.

Purpose

This scheme is to ensure that young brilliant children of deceased armed forces personnel who lost their lives in the service of the Nation are not denied access to quality education. This purpose is designed to give back to the families of deceased armed forces personnel who lost their lives in service to the Nation, by awarding scholarships to children of such families annually on the 15th of January in commemoration of the Armed Forces Remembrance Day. They will be selected based on their individual performance and awarded scholarships to cover tuition, Examination fees and School supplies.

Prospective Applicants must have met the following Criteria:

- Applicant must be a Child of a deceased member of the Armed forces
- Must currently attend any Junior Secondary School in Nigeria before applying for the Scholarship award
- Must show good academic performance.
- Prospective awardees parents/ guardians can pick up and submit application forms at the stated centre or Application Form can be filled online with passport photograph attached and can also be downloaded online @ www.axiomlearn.com.

Application Process:

The following documents would be required to prove the eligibility of the applicant:

- Death Certificate of the Deceased Parent
- Evidence that the Deceased Parent served as a Nigerian Armed Forces Personnel (Photograph of the personnel may be attached)
- Applicant's Birth Certificate

- Examination Report Card from previous year and current year
- 4 Passport Photographs
- Evidence of Enrolment into Junior Secondary School
- May present a copy of death gratuity slip
- Applicant's Account Details or Applicant's Parent or Guardian Account detail

Selection of qualified Awardees will be strictly based on **MERIT**.
